



OBSERVATION


Jinat Parveen, Assistant Teacher, Bengali (H/PG) : The Petitioner is claiming that she has been appointed as Assistant Teacher, Bengali (H/PG) in terms of Special Meeting No. 04 dated 27.02.2016. On scrutiny of the original Resolution Book, we do not find any such resolution dated 27.02.2016. The Petitioner had no requisite qualification on the date of her alleged recruitment in Ajangachi High Madrasah, Howrah. Mijanur Islam, Headmaster specifically stated that the Petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being No. 93-SE/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015 and she never worked as Assistant Teacher, Bengali (H/PG) of the Madrasah. The claim of the Petitioner is false and fabricated. Ajoy Kumar Pal, the D.I. of Schools, Howrah also stated by filing a report thereof that the Petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being No. 93-SE/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015.

The Work Done Certificate was never issued by the Headmaster of the Madrasah in favour of the Petitioner. We also do not find the signature of the Petitioner in the official attendance register.

Under the circumstances stated above, we are of the considered view that the Petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being No. 93-SE/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015 and she never worked in the Madrasah.






OBSERVATION

Niroja Jafrin, Group-C (Clerk) : The Petitioner is claiming that she has been appointed as Group-C (Clerk) in terms of Special Meeting No. 04 dated 27.02.2016. On scrutiny of the original Resolution Book, we do not find any such resolution dated 27.02.2016. Mijanur Islam, Headmaster specifically stated that the Petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being No. 93-SE/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015 and she never worked as Group-C (Clerk) of the Madrasah. The claim of the Petitioner is false and fabricated. Ajoy Kumar Pal, the D.I. of Schools, Howrah also stated by filing a report thereof that the Petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being No. 93-SE/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015.
