There was no valid Managing Committee on the date of alleged recruitment of the petitioner. The petitioner had no requisite qualification to be appointed as Assistant Teacher. The Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 93-SE/S/10R-14/2013 dated 09.02.2015 were not complied with. The Ad-hoc Managing Committee had not authority to recruit the petitioner.

Under the circumstances stated above, we are of considered view that the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03.03.2016 were never complied with and the Ad-hoc Managing Committee having no legal authority to recruit the petitioner, has illegally recruited the petitioner and thereby the Work Done Certificate or the attested copy of the

Attendance Register have become redundant.

Despite service of successive notices upon Headmaster/Teacher-in-Charge of Gimageria Welfare High Madrasah, Purba Medinipur, the concerned person did not turn up before the Committee to help the Committee in the process of verification as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court by it's order dated 02.02.2023 in contempt petition No. 352/2022. Instead, the Secretary has sent an email dated 29.05.2023 stating inter alia that the process of hearing adopted by the Committee has been challenged before the Hon'ble Supreme Court being case diary No. 17682-2023 for not supplying the copy of recording of submission of the Managing Committee/appointing authority of the Madrasah and accordingly sought for time for hearing after completion of the hearing of the above case diary No. 17682-2023 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. As per the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the mode and manner of verification process has to be decided by the Committee and such verification process has to be completed within a stipulated period. In that view of this matter, we can't allow such prayer of the Secretary.

The Teacher-in-Charge has sent some documents by post for perusal of the Committee.

As per report of West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education, there was no valid Managing Committee of the Madrasah on the date of alleged recruitment of the petitioner but the concerned Madrasah was duly recognized by the Board on the date of the alleged recruitment.

The petitioner is claiming that he was recruited on 20.01.2016 as Group - C (Clerk) of Gimageria Welfare High Madrasah, Purba Medinipur and he has been working there since 01.07.2018. The vacancies were published in THE STATESMAN pursuant to the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in MAT 473/2014 dated 25.08.2015. The Letter of Appointment reveals that the Resolution was adopted by the Ad-hoc Managing Committee. The report of West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education clearly reveals that there was no sanction of the concerned Madrasah from the Board on the date of alleged recruitment of the petitioner and there was no valid Managing Committee of the Madrasah on that date. Ad-hoc Managing Committee does not have the power to recruit Teachers.

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The Resolution being sl.No. 13/16 dated 17.01.2016 attested by Teacher-in-Charge also reveals that - Mr. Mojammel Ali Shah, Mr. Ahmed Hossain Ali Shah, Mr. Amanur Hossain, Mr. Rahabar Ali Shah had signed such Resolution on behalf of Ad-hoc Managing Committee. The documents filed by the Teacher-in-Charge contains the order dated 17.06.2014 passed by Hon'ble High Court in MAT No. 943 of 2014 & CAN 5475 of 2014. It is apparent from such order that the Hon'ble Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court Calcutta constituted an Ad-hoc Managing Committee with the following members for running the day-to-day administration of the said institution till the disposal of the appeal, with further direction that the Teacher-in-Charge to act as the Secretary of the said Ad-hoc Managing Committee:

- 1. Founder member Mr. Mojammel Ali Shah
- 2. Teacher-in-Charge Mr. Ahmed Hossain Ali Shah.
- 3. Teachers' representative Mr. Amanur Hossain.

- 5. One Government Nominee Jharna Gathact, A.D.I., Contai Sub-Division, Purba Medinipur.

The appeal has been finally disposed of on 24.07.2014 directing the Trial Court to dispose of the Writ Application being WP. No. 13673 (W of 2014) keeping the order dated 17.06.2014 intact till disposal of such Writ (in matters of Ad-hoc arrangement of the Managing Committee).

It is crystal clear from such order of the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta that the Ad-hoc Managing Committee of Gimageria Welfare High Madrasah, Purba Medinipur was constituted to run the day-to-day administration consisting of the aforesaid persons only and we find that the said persons have only signed on Resolution No. 15/16 dated 21.02.2016. That clearly goes to show that the Ad-hoc Managing Committee had no power to recruit any Teacher but the Ad-hoc Managing Committee was constituted to run the day-to-day administration of the Gimageria Welfare High Madrasah (H.S), Purba Medinipur.

In such circumstances, the process of initiation of recruitment, the recruitment of the petitioner, joining report before the Teacher-in-Charge, and all such process of recruitment are being hit by the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in MAT No. 943 of 2014 dated 17.06.2014 and 24.07.2014 wherein the Ad-hoc Committee was mainly permitted to manage the day-to-day administration of the said institution.

The Ad-hoc Managing Committee, therefore, had no authority to recruit any Teacher in view of the circumstances stated hereinabove.

The report of the A.D.I., Contai as well as D.I. of Schools, Purba Medinipur clearly spells out that the Rules of Recruitment as per Govt. Notification No. 93-SE/S/10R-14/2013 dated

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09.02.2015 were not complied with and the Ad-hoc Managing Committee of Gimageria Welfare High Madrasah, Purba Medinipur never took permission from the office of the A.D.I., Contai/D.I. of Schools, Purba Medinipur for any purpose in matters of recruitment and the concerned Managing Committee never complied with the aforesaid recruitment rules or the procedure of approval for appointment as per office records.

We are constrained to observe that the Ad-hoc Managing Committee, having no authority to recruit any Teacher, has recruited the petitioner and did not even point out that the Ad-hoc Committee was only constituted for running the day-to-day administration of the Madrasah. Therefore, the entire process of recruitment of the petitioner becomes illegal, without jurisdiction and contrary to the order of the Hon'ble Division Bench passed in MAT No. 943 of 2014.

There was no valid Managing Committee on the date of alleged recruitment of the petitioner. The petitioner had no requisite qualification to be appointed as Assistant Teacher.
