


## OBSERVATION


**Zohorul Islam, Assistant Teacher, English (Pass):-** The petitioner, Zohorul Islam, having no requisite qualification to be appointed as Assistant Teacher of English (Pass) of Kantirpa N.K. Sr. Madrasah, Uttar Dinajpur. He is claiming himself as Assistant Teacher on the basis of an imaginary Resolution of the Selection Committee of the Madrasah being No. SPL/01/K.N.K. Sr. M (Fazil)/2016 dated 09/02/2016 of the Managing Committee of the Madrasah.


Abdul Malek, the Teacher-in-Charge of the Madrasah, has specifically stated that no Resolution was adopted by the Managing Committee of the Madrasah for recruitment of the petitioner. ~~But, he~~ had never seen the petitioner to attend the Madrasah to work as Assistant Teacher in the Madrasah. The Madrasah has been managed by the Administrator since December, 2020. As per the Teacher-in-Charge of the Madrasah, the claim of the petitioner as Assistant Teacher, is fabricated and false. The down loaded record of approved teachers of the Madrasah from Banglar Sikha Portal, does not reveal the name of the petitioner as Assistant Teacher of the Madrasah. The Work Done Certificate has not been granted by the Teacher-in-Charge/Headmaster of the Madrasah but, the same has been granted by the Secretary of the Managing Committee up to 27/02/2020. 
## OBSERVATION

Sr. M (Fazil)/2017 dated 06/02/2017 of the Managing Committee of the Madrasah.



## OBSERVATION




On the strength of Special Meeting No. KHM/D/SPL-01A/2018 dated 10.03.2018, the petitioner is claiming that he was recruited by the Managing Committee.


On scrutiny of the Resolution Book of the Managing Committee, we do not find any such Resolution. as has been mentioned in the appointment letter of the petitioner. The Headmaster specifically stated that there is no signature of the petitioner in the official Attendance Register and he never worked in any capacity in the Madrasah. The A.D.I, Basirhat also corroborated the Headmaster.

The Work Done Certificate issued by the Secretary has had no relevance/importance since there is no signature of the Petitioner in the official Attendance Register.

Therefore, we are satisfied that the petitioner was never recruited following the Rules of Recruitment being Govt. Notification No. 486-MD/O/2M-11/2016 dated 03.03.2016 and never worked in the Madrasah.
