




OBSERVATION

The Work Done Certificate also does not find support from the entries made in the official attendance register. The separate attendance register does not bear the signature of the Headmaster / Teacher-in-charge but, the same appears to have been manufactured for the purpose of verification. A separate attendance register presumably have been prepared for the purpose of this verification process. He had no requisite qualification to be appointed as Asstt. Teacher, since on the date of alleged appointment, he had no B. Ed. Degree.
